We have updated our privacy policy so that it conforms to the new General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR) which is mandatory as of 25th May, 2018.

MP Port de Roses, SA already complies with the requirements of Spanish data protection regulations. Therefore, the change to the new GDPR does not involve any major changes to the way in which we process data.

With this revision, we offer clear and detailed information about the use we make of your personal data, contained in the files owned by MP Port de Roses, SA. We have provided a brief summary below.

- Who is the controller of your personal data?

- For what purposes do we process your personal data?

We process your data in order to fulfil the objectives and provide the services contracted, as well as to inform you of the port activity and other events organised by MP Port de Roses, SA, including the promotion and marketing of its services.

- What is the legal basis for the processing of your data?

The legal basis for the processing of your data is the undertaking of the contract or the commercial relationship that you have entered into with MP Port de Roses, SA.

- To which recipients will your personal data be communicated?

The recipients of the information are all the departments of MP Port de Roses, SA necessary in order to manage the services contracted, including the communication of the data to subcontractors whose collaboration is necessary for the specific fulfilment of the object of the contract.

The refusal to provide your data, or to allow it to be processed, will result in it being impossible to offer you the services contracted.

The data will be stored for as long as the contractual relationship is maintained and whilst its termination has not been requested, and, in all cases, in compliance with the legal prescribed periods that may be applicable.

Your data will not be transferred to third parties nor will any international data transfers be made, except in compliance with a legal obligation.

- What are your rights regarding your personal data?

You can exercise your right of access to your personal data, as well as request the rectification of any inaccurate data or, if applicable, request its deletion when the data is no longer necessary for the purposes that it was collected. You may also request the portability, restriction and opposition to the processing of your data, under certain circumstances and for reasons relating to your particular situation.
